The Art of Dance

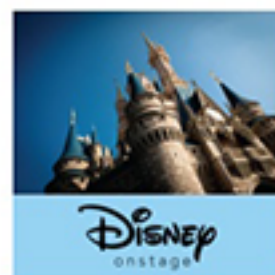
