

Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

- Be aware of all Metro Dance Academy policies and Student Code of Conduct.
- Communicate regularly with Metro Dance Academy.
- Ensure that the student attends class regularly, in proper attire and on time.
- Inform the Metro Dance Academy promptly about absences or late arrivals.
- Ensure to pick up students no more than 15 minutes after class ends.
- Encourage and help child to follow the student code of conduct.
- Uphold decisions and recommendations as directed by the Dance Director.
- Support the dance curriculum as implemented by the instructors including student differences pertaining to skill level.
- Support students to comply with instructor and class time expectations as set out by the instructor.
- **The Metro Gymnastics Center Safe Sport policy** prohibits one-on-one contact with instructors and minors.
 - Therefore, when a dancer is receiving private instruction a parent/guardian must be present during entire time. Another staff member would be considered a second adult.
 - If class attendance level reaches a single student, a parent/guardian must be present during the entire class session. Another staff member would be considered a second adult.
- Please do not interrupt classes while in progress. We recommend arranging a conference if your dancer's instructor teaches back-to-back classes and is not available to speak to you in private. To schedule a conference with your child's instructor(s), email danceatmetro@gmail.com. Give your name, your child's name, a daytime and evening phone number and the name of the instructor you wish to connect with. Title the subject of the email INSTRUCTOR CONFERENCE.
- Parent viewing areas are located outside both dance studios. Please do not disturb dance class and be aware of distractions that may occur including; loud conversations and volume of electronic devices. Please no running, gymnastics, or other sports in the hallways outside of the studios.
- Metro Dance Academy is not responsible for lost items.
- Act in a manner that is respectful and courteous to all
